PROVINCIAL & REGIONAL PARKS

ASESSIPPI PROVINCIAL PARK on Lake of Prairies (30 min drive)

The park is settled at the south end of Lake of the Prairies, a man-made lake flanked by the magnificent valley walls of the Assiniboine and Shell rivers. The lake has one of the largest walleye fisheries in the area. The Park includes a large campground with over 100 mostly serviced sites and a new playground. There are many other private campgrounds around the lake.

Asessippi Ski Area & Resort - the best snow sports facility from Thunder Bay to Calgary. Winter activities include skiing, snowboarding, downhill snow tubing & snowshowing with a full rental fleet. 
